TAHAWUS CENTER CURATORSHIP INTERN

Appleby Foundation offers rare opportunity to develop solid curatorial, and gallery directorial skills, in a unique setting on Main Street in Au Sable Forks, NY. The position is unpaid.

The 4-6 week summer project is located in a quaint rural village at the confluence of the Ausable River branches, in the gorgeous Adirondack Mountain region (5.5 hrs north of NYC). Flexible start and finish time. Close to magnificent outdoor recreation opportunities such as hiking, swimming, fishing, biking, etc.

The Tahawus Learning Center (TLC), established in 2011, now occupies a 101-year old building still undergoing renovations. It is a development project of Appleby Foundation, to create a new hub for cultural and education activities in the region, with the goal to spur Main Street revitalization led by the visual and performing arts. The Windows Gallery initially opened on the ground floor, and relocated to the 2nd floor as renovations were completed in 2013.

The candidate must possess strong writing skills for press releases, reports, and communication and organization skills for coordination of events, volunteer staff, and sponsors. Familiarity with range of dance activities (modern, ballet, rehearsal needs, class needs, yoga, pilates) is a plus, along with interest/ experience in visual art areas: photography, painting. The candidate will work both alone and in collaboration with others, should be independent and inventive.

RKB seeks an enterprising individual to manage, oversee the summer activities in the building, even as parts of the building it are still under renovation. Duties include assisting, coordinating with Gallery exhibits, opening reception, community outreach, helping to coordinate special events, and a variety of jobs.

Must have a car and a computer. Work related travel will be reimbursed. Work hours are fairly flexible and deadline or project driven. Plenty of free time to explore the scenic surroundings of Lake Placid, Lake Champlain, etc.
