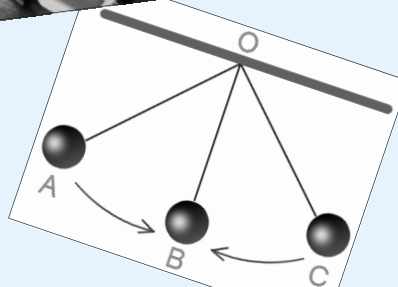
Eydon Thomashow, Assistant, is a certified tutor of students in physics and math. She is majoring in astrophysics at Oberlin College, in Ohio.

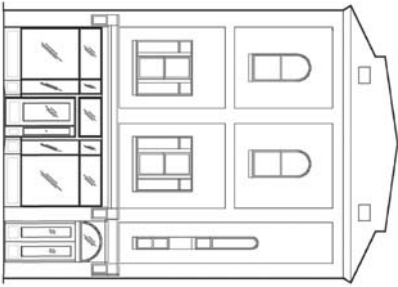

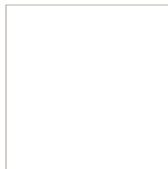
