**TA-HA-WUS**,  
thought to mean  
**CLOUD -SPLITTER**,  
today stands tallest of  
the buildings lining  
Main Street.  
**Constructed in 1911** by  
the Masons, the Tahawus  
Lodge was one of the few  
major buildings to survive



the great fire of 1925. During its 100-year history, it has housed banquet and lodge rooms, a post office, a laundromat, a store, the Adirondack Record, one of the oldest newspapers continuously published in the Adirondacks. After the mill-closed, it fell into decline over the past 40 years. Appleby Foundation acquired the building in 2009. Today, **Tea Time Antiques Store** occupies the ground floor, and is open 3pm-6pm daily.
